

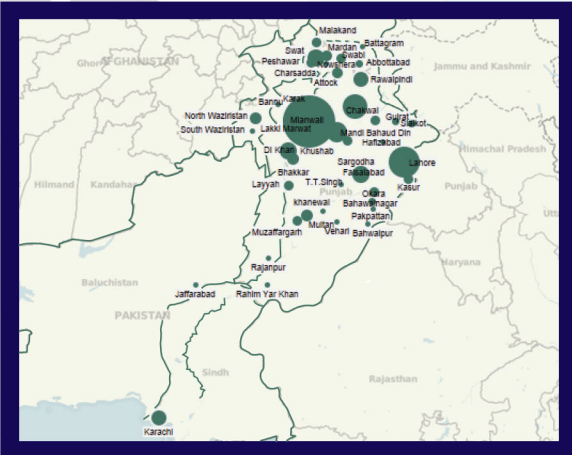

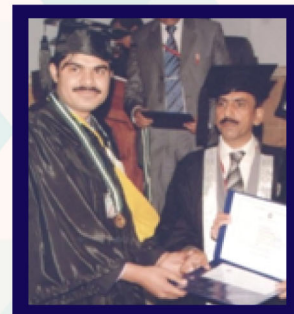
Map Showing 43 Districts from which Namal College Student Body Hails

Lab Engineer of Namal Won Gold Medal at UET

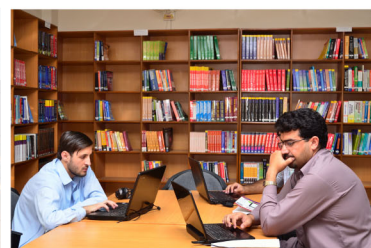

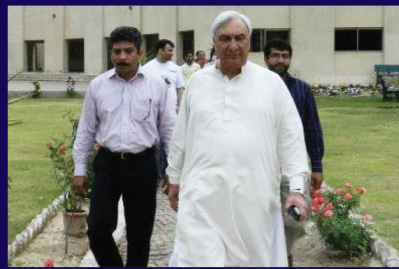

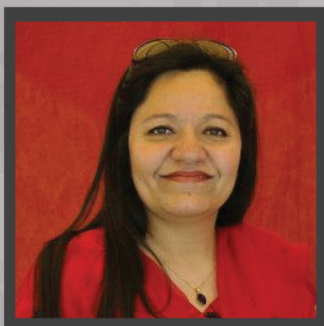
Visit of Mr. Rehman Mir
