Namal School

Situated near Namal Institute is a mini-Namal; a primary school where close to 300 kids from Mianwali and neighboring towns and villages come to think, learn and explore. Some of these children travel 100 kilometers to reach this school!

The school was started in 2014 by faculty members of Namal Institute whose children were entering school-age. The wives of many of these faculty members became teachers and their dedication and hard work transformed Namal School into a model educational center for the entire region. Each year, as the students progressed from one class to another, a new class was added. Today the school offers education from playgroup to 8th class and remains the only quality institute of its kind in the region.





Namal Agripreneurs: Making a Difference

Sufyan Abdur Rehman and Kashif Latif Chaudhary graduated from Namal in 2019 with a degree in Computer Science. Both were selected for Student Entrepreneurship Program at National University of Singapore, and are now jointly running and managing a hydroponics farm near Raiwind, Lahore. 'When we went to Singapore, on an exchange program, we were intrigued by the game-changing technologies they had employed in the agricultural sector,' says Sufyan.

'Hydroponics is the future of agriculture,' adds Kashif. 'The technology uses far less land and does not require much water and the best thing is that it does not use pesticides.'

Sufyan and Kashif have successfully grown tomatoes, lettuces, broccoli, and a dozen more vegetables by growing them on vertically stacked layers and by employing climate control systems and IoT (Internet of Things). They are also marketing their produce by connecting with restaurants and major chain stores.





Namal Installs Weather Forecasting Technology

Namal Dam has got an upgrade! Namal Institute's Center for Artificial Intelligence & Big Data collaborated with LUMS' Center for Water Informatics & Technology (WIT) to install sensors at Namal Dam which detect weather anomalies and predict floods and droughts using artificial intelligence.







Reinvigorating the Dairy Industry

Developed by Namal Institute, 'Mera Maweshi' is a mobile phone application that is all set to redefine the dairy industry of Pakistan. It allows farmers to timely diagnose the diseases of their animals and get valuable advice based on the list of symptoms entered. The project was initiated by Namal's Center of Precision Agriculture and is being carried out in collaboration with LUMS, University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences (UVAS), and District Livestock Office of Mianwali.

- Can diagnose more than 33 diseases;
